RESIDENTIAL FALL CLEANUP 2024

Monday, Oct. 7th – Thursday, Oct. 10th

Acceptable Items:

- ✓ Tree Trimmings / Branches
 Must be bundled neatly and branches separated to run through chipper. Under 10cm in diameter and 3 meters in length.
- ✓ Leaves (bagged)
- ✓ Organic Materials

The Village of Slocan will only pick up organic materials. All other materials will be left and it will be the owner's responsibility to take to the appropriate recycling facility or transfer station.

Residents are requested to place any organic materials for pickup on the boulevard where you would normally place your garbage can. Any items placed on the boulevard after October 10th will not be removed and the home owner will be responsible for disposing of the materials.

FREE VEHICLE REMOVAL

The week of October 7th, the Village will once again be offering **FREE** vehicle removal. If you are interested in participating, please contact the Village Office to register. We will require the make, model, colour and license plate # of your vehicle (unlicensed vehicles will also be accepted). Proof of ownership is required. Please remember to move your vehicle onto the Village Boulevard on your scheduled day of pick-up. This program was initiated in response to Village beautification and in preparation for winter snow clearing.

There is no cost to the Village or residents for this service.

VILLAGE OF SLOCAN MEETING NOTES

September 9th, 2024 – Regular Meeting

- Council approved the Halloween Hoot Committee Draft Terms of Reference as presented, and there is a call out to the community for membership.
- The Slocan Community Library Upgrade Project was awarded \$2,500 from the RDCK Community Development Fund.
- Public Works September Report, was presented and accompanied with a report on the Water Treatment Plant Filtration System Bypass.
- The Village will be contacting the MLA with concerns regarding the Trailhead Project and lack of action.
- Mo Haroun spoke to the Laneway Housing Initiative, and expressed interest in presenting to Council at a future meeting.
- Joanna Feenstra confirmed \$100k is proposed to be paid down on the Mill Site debt, and commented on the great number of logs coming down the river as a result of the forest fires.

SLOCAN TRANSFER STATION CLOSED AS OF OCTOBER 5th

The Slocan Transfer Station will be temporarily closed, due to construction, beginning October 5th, 2024. Completion of the work is expected in December. Slocan upgrades are the last of a larger project to replace aging infrastructure, increase site capacity, and improve the efficiency of waste management in the area, following upgrades to both the Rosebery and Nakusp waste facilities. The RDCK may increase hours of operation at the closest neighbouring facility for both waste and recycling, if required.
